The 4th annual Iowa Choreography Festival is an art experience bringing multiple artists together to create new work. We are proudly supported by Iowa Dance Theatre as a non-profit festival.

Each choreographer or movement artist must work with a musician to create a piece or a work in progress. They also must work with an artist and/or designer to make costumes or props. These collaborators can be people the choreographer, artist, or designer finds on their own, or they may choose from the Choreography Festival's pool of applicants. This will allow us to represent many different art forms during each performance and encourage collaboration and communication within the community.

While we are a performance opportunity, it is essential that we also allow all admitted artists to expand their horizons with classes from multiple art forms. We will have a week-long movement workshop free of charge for all participating artists. There will also be classes throughout the summer taught by admitted artists that are donation-based.

As a musician, you can send us original music that you think will be a good fit for stage movement. You can also create something new with your choreographer this summer. We encourage performing live when possible. Working with a choreographer can bring new light to your music and an opportunity to reach new audiences. Choreographers will need a way to rehearse to the music you plan on using this summer, though improvisation is also welcome.

I'm not a composer but a musician who would love to perform- should I apply? Yes! If you can perform live, you may perform original OR free domain music.

Why do I need to work with other artists?

This festival strives for artists to push the bounds of what would be created independently. Artists can specialize and hone their craft in a group effort to develop elevated works.

Will everyone who applies get a chance to be a part of the festival? While we try to create a space for everyone, time and space are limited.

I'm an artist and have an idea for a piece, but I don't know where to start.
